**ADMISSION TO DMLT & DRT COURSES (Recognized By Government of Kerala) IN  
MANAGEMENT CATEGORY SEATS**

**Information brochure & instructions to the applicants**

**1. Number of Seats and Seat distribution:**

Applications for admission to DMLT & DRT for 2018-19 in Management category seats are invited.

**Distribution of the management seats will be as follows:**

- Two (2) seats are open to all candidates.
- Three (3) seats are reserved for applicants from Christian Community.
- Two (2) seats are reserved for religious nuns of Roman Catholic Church.
- Eight (8) seats are reserved for candidates from Syro-Malabar Church.  
Unfilled seats in category (iii) and (iv) will be reverted to category (ii). Unfilled seats in category (ii) will be reverted to open category (i).

**2. Academic Eligibility for DMLT/ DRT Courses:**

- Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or examinations recognized equivalent thereto, with at least 60% marks or above in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together, are eligible. It will be 55% marks in the case of religious nuns of Roman Catholic Church.
- Candidates who have passed VHSE with Medical Laboratory Technology with at least 70% marks or above put together for Physics, Chemistry and Biology are eligible for DMLT course. It will be 60% marks in the case of religious nuns of Roman Catholic Church

**Duration of both courses is two years.**

- DRT –Duration of the course is 2 years with one year additional training in radiotherapy in the same institution. The candidates completing Diploma in Radiological Technology will not be eligible to work as Radio Therapy Technologist from 1-1-2014 onwards as per the decision of AERB without this additional training.**

**3. Age Requirements:**

All applicants shall have completed 17 years of age on 31.12.2018

**4. TUITION FEES:**

The Tuition Fee for entire duration of the 2 years of DMLT & DRT course is **Rs.110000 (Rupees one lakh ten thousand only)**

5. **Special Fees:** Besides the tuition fees, the candidate is liable to pay the following categories of fees and any other fees that may be notified by the DME Government of Kerala, from time to time. The following fees are subject to change as per the decision of the Management.

#### 7. Scheme of Admission:

- i. Application Form will be available on payment of Rs 400 (Rupees Four hundred only) as DD at the Paramedical office from 23-05-18 onwards (9 am to 3 pm). The above mentioned payment is non-refundable. Application form will not be sent by post. DD may be drawn in favour of: Amala Cancer Hospital Society, payable at Thrissur. Application forms may also be downloaded.
- ii. The applicants may also send the applications by Registered Post. The Institution will not be responsible for non-receipt or late receipt of applications, under any circumstances.
- iii. The application forms should be completed carefully, furnishing the entire information called for. Late and incomplete applications and applications not in the prescribed form will be summarily rejected.
- iv. Applicants shall obtain **acknowledgement** with an application number assigned from the **paramedical office for the applications submitted in person, from 9am to 3pm during working days.**
- v. Application should be handwritten by the candidate and only BLOCK LETTERS may be used to fill out the application. The Photocopies of the following documents duly attested by a gazetted officer shall be attached with the Application (The original documents will have to be submitted at the time of admission).
  - a) SSLC Certificate
  - b) Mark list of the qualifying examination.
  - c) Transfer Certificate and Course & Conduct Certificate
  - d) Applicants applying for the seats reserved for the Christian community and Syro-Malabar church should submit a copy of letter from their respective Parish Priest, failing which the candidate will not be considered for admission in the concerned category. Religious nuns must produce a certificate issued by the concerned Major Superior.
